Troubleshoots electrical component problems with traffic signal; resolve problems and monitor traffic signal to ensure no further problems occur. Assessed and repairs knocked down or damaged stop signs; replace sleeve, pole and sign if necessary. Fabricates and installs school zone flashers at designed school; flasher is programmed and assigned an identification number; flasher is monitored and maintained for proper working order. Fabricates and installs missing or damaged street signs as needed. Responsible for placing signs at appropriate locations at construction site; flag traffic around work zone through communication with co-workers. Participates in activities and duties related to emergency management during a local state of disaster as directed by appropriate county managers.
